Municipal Tax Exempt Lease Purchase Financing re: 5-year Capital Improvement Plan

**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A MUNICIPAL TAX-EXEMPT
LEASE PURCHASE FINANCING AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Town of East Hartford approved the purchase of various capital equipment including police cars, pick-up and utility trucks, a leaf vacuum, a tractor with attachments, a prisoner transport vehicle, and wellness equipment as part of the Town of East Hartford's Approved 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan for the fiscal years 2015-16 through 2019-20; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the various capital equipment designated for lease-purchase financing totals \$767,000; and

WHEREAS, the Town will budget \$202,000 in fiscal years 2016-17 through 2019-20 in the General Operating Fund to pay principal and interest on the purchases.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the Town of East Hartford is authorized to enter into a master lease purchase agreement and related documents with TD Equipment Finance, Inc. or their affiliates in the principal amount not to exceed \$767,000. The interest rate, payment schedule and other details of the financing shall be mutually determined between the company and the Mayor, whose signatures will indicate approval of specific terms and conditions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town declares its intent to be reimbursed for any temporary advances from the General Fund to pay for any part of the equipment from proceeds of the lease financing in accordance with Treasury Regulation 26 CFR 1.103-18 and/or 26CFR1.150-2.





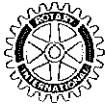

On August 2, 2011 the Town Council voted unanimously to allow the Rotary Club of East Hartford free use of the Veterans Memorial Clubhouse for its weekly meetings, provided the Club donates a minimum of \$10,000 for the benefit of East Hartford residents on a yearly basis. In addition, a report containing this information is due to the Mayor, Town Council, and Finance Director by July 1st of each year.

Attached is a report of our financial activity in this regard for the period May 2013 through the present. You will recognize a number of large donations such as the Bookmobile and support of the computer classroom about to be opened at the expanded Raymond Library. We have consistently supported a number of other social service and recreation programs in town and are most proud of our annual scholarship program for graduating high school residents. The total for 2013-14 is \$80,348; and for 2014-15 to date it is \$39,647.

The Rotary Club's motto of "Service Above Self" could not be fulfilled as readily without waiving the fee for use of the Veterans Memorial Clubhouse. Because our Club meets weekly year-round, the fee for the facility would cost us over \$17,000 annually. Thank you for helping us to provide financial support to so many worthy local organizations and events.

Attached please find a copy of the amusement permit application submitted by **The East Hartford Patriotic Commission** by **Melodie S. Wilson, its Chairperson**. The applicant seeks to hold the Town's annual **Memorial Day Parade** on **Monday, May 25, 2015** between the hours of **9:30 AM to noon with music during the same hours**. The parade route will begin by going west on Burnside Avenue beginning at 777 Burnside Avenue (East Hartford Middle School), to Hillside St., then south on Hillside Street to its conclusion at the Hillside Cemetery.

Pursuant to Town Ordinance (TO) 5-3, a review of the application was completed by the Directors of the Fire, Health, Parks & Recreation, Public Works Departments and the Offices of the Corporation Counsel and Finance.

The **Offices of Corporation Counsel and Finance** approve the application as submitted.

The **Fire, Health and Parks & Recreation Departments** approve the application as submitted and state there are no anticipated costs to their Departments for this event.

The **Public Works Department** approves the application as submitted subject to the following:

- The applicant shall obtain a Highway Use Permit from the DOT District 1 Office for the closure and detour of Burnside Avenue (Route 44).
- The applicant shall coordinate the placement and removal of barricades and signs with the Department of Public Works and Park Maintenance.
- **The anticipated cost to the department for this event is \$2,900.00.**

The **Police Department** can supply adequate police protection with the hiring of additional police personnel for the conduct of this activity and offers the following comments:

- The proposed route requires the establishment of two (2) complex detour routes. This will require employing approximately thirty-five (35) Police Officers to establish and maintain the parade route and traffic detours. The majority of these Officers will be provided through overtime hiring.

- **Anticipated cost to the Department for this event is \$12,000.00.**
- The applicant has made or will make application to the State Traffic Commission for the necessary road closure permit for Route 44 (Burnside Avenue) and to the Town's Director of Public Works for Hillside Street. It is anticipated that these permits will be approved.
- The necessary prohibition of all vehicles on the parade route (Burnside Avenue between Long Hill and Hillside Streets and between Hillside and Roberts Streets) will severely disrupt the traffic flow in the vicinity. This prohibition is anticipated to be for a period of approximately 3.5 hours. Alternative routes to most intersecting streets are available. It should be noted that during the road closure period, vehicles will not be allowed to exit or enter onto Burnside Avenue from the following streets:

Bidwell Street	Moore Avenue
Church Street	Price Court
Elmer Street	School Street
Francis Street	Scotland Road
Hanmer Street	Terry Street
Howard Court	Williams Street
Larrabee Street	Wind Road

- The posting of temporary NO PARKING signs and the placement of temporary traffic barricades and over numerous detour signs will be accomplished by the Public Works Department. These signs and barricades facilitate the closing of the parade route. Because of the complexity and scope of this task, it will be necessary to establish early detours, and close the parade route to vehicles well in advance of the actual parade obstruction.
- During the parade, access to the area for emergency vehicles will continue to be provided. Police personnel equipped with two-way radios are stationed along the parade route at strategic locations. Should access by emergency vehicles be necessary, the parade is halted, and marking units shifted to one side of the street, thereby allowing for the safe passage of emergency vehicles and personnel.
- No vehicles will be permitted inside Hillside Cemetery. It will be necessary for parade route vehicles to be parked on side streets in the area of Roberts Street.

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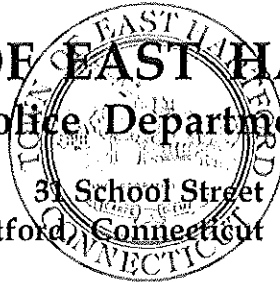

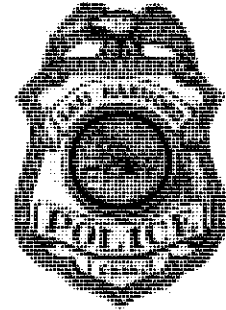

RE: Properties Recommended for Tax Lien Sale – Seven lists

Attached please find seven lists of properties being recommended for the town's annual tax lien sale. The lists are as follows:

1. New liens by unique address	735,960.90 (page 7)
2. New liens by unique name	241,013.66 (page 10)
3. Defaulted payment arrangements – non mobile homes	163,796.20 (page 12)
4. Defaulted payment arrangements – mobile homes	46,458.73 (page 12a)
5. Sub lien assignment to original winning bidder	362,883.18 (page 16)
6. Sub lien assignment to original winning bidder	74,731.70 (page 24)
7. Mobile sub lien assignment to original winning bidder	14,592.46 (page 25)

Please note that all amounts are compiled through March 31, 2015 and will increase based on the application of interest and lien fees through the date of sale. Based on prior lien sales, the policy criteria applied by the Tax Office that results in a property being selected for lien sale dictates that any real estate delinquency in excess of \$10,000 or any amount when the delinquency spans any portion of three grand list years will be sent for sale. The application of that policy resulted in the creation of "List 1".

We have also added additional criteria where individual owners who owe smaller amounts on multiple properties are also included. The properties compiled under this scenario are noted as "List 2". Defaulted payment plans are noted as "List 3 and 4".

Finally, prior lien sale properties where subsequent tax liens need to be assigned to the bidder holding the original tax liens are noted as "List 5, 6, and 7". Know that these subsequent liens are being assigned at 100% of the outstanding balance.

As background information related to the process followed by the Tax Office, the collection process completed for each grand list year is summarized below.

- The tax bill first installment legal notice is published (the middle of June).
- An individual tax bill is printed and mailed to the property address (late June).
- If full payment is not received, an individual delinquent letter is mailed (August).
- The tax bill second installment legal notice is published (late December).
- If full payment is not received, an individual demand letter is mailed (February).
- If amounts remain unpaid, an individual notice of intention to file lien letter is mailed (May).
- If amounts remain unpaid, a lien is filed by the Tax Collector (by June 30th).

As was done the past few years, the town will issue a tax lien sale request for proposal (RFP). When the town has accepted bids in the past, the town was able to collect 100% of the tax due on the parcels when it sold its lien. On some properties, the owner came forward and entered into an agreement with the town to deposit an initial payment approximating 25% of the taxes due while agreeing to retire the remaining balance over 36 months while keeping new taxes current.

Like past lien sales, the town will advertise these properties and request sealed bids (on lists 1, 2, 3, and 4). The bids received by the town will be opened and analyzed by the Administration who then will return to the Town Council with appropriate recommendations for sale. The Finance Department, including the Tax Office, will work closely with Corporation Counsel to facilitate this sale.

In closing, while it is regrettable that the town has to initiate this action, despite our best efforts, we have been unable to secure collection with these particular properties. Accordingly, to maintain a fair and equitable tax collection system for the town, we must initiate this action.

Suggested Motion

To authorize the administration to conduct a tax lien sale by way of a request for proposal (RFP) and to seek and receive sealed bids pursuant to an invitation to bid on a number of tax liens held by the town on specific real property as listed on lists 1, 2, 3, and 4 attached to a memorandum from the Mayor to the Town Council subject to the following four conditions:

1. The Collector of Revenue shall notify the record owner of each property subject to a lien included in the tax lien sale, by certified mail, that the lien is being included in the request for proposal and invitation to bid, and that they should contact the Town immediately to pay the taxes or seek a payment plan if they wish to try to keep the Town's tax liens on their property from being sold;
2. In order to qualify for a payment plan, the property owner must meet the following three criteria:
 - They must remit 25% of the outstanding amount due
 - They cannot have defaulted on a prior payment arrangement
 - Their property must not have active property code violations
3. The letters from the Collector of Revenue to each property owner shall notify the property owner that the purchaser of the tax lien on their property shall have the right to foreclose on that property, and
4. The Administration shall return to the Town Council with the results of the request for proposal and that the proposal for each tax lien must be approved by the Town Council before it is sold.

And further to authorize the administration to assign the tax liens as listed on lists 5, 6 and 7 to the vendors who currently hold the prior year tax liens on these properties.
