EHHS Students Wins National Award: Resume, Interview, Took Top Honors

WASHINGTON DC – John Drew, a senior at East Hartford High School, won Second Place in a national employability contest this weekend at the JAG National Student Leadership Academy in Washington, DC.

John is a participant in Jobs for America's Graduates (JAG) CT program, and he travelled to NSLA with four other students from Manchester, New Britain and New Haven. The Employability Skills event involved developing a letter of application and a resume for a simulated job opening. Candidates then took part in a simulated interview. Contestants were rated on neatness, spelling and grammar, content and completeness, and personal presentation.



JAG came to East Hartford in January of 2014, as an elective-credit course teaching professional skills and offering individual mentoring and counseling to students. Students also take part in a Career Association, designing and carrying out community services projects, and 12 months of follow-up services after graduation. JAG also offers smaller class sized and help with a personal employment and career plan.

John enrolled in September and was elected President of his class' Career Association. He went an extra mile and also delivered a hand-written thank-you note after his interview.

"JAG has made me realize the definition of hard work," John said. "It's made me realize that when you put 100 percent effort into everything you do, good outcomes will result...Before I was that one kid in the back of the class who would do nothing and cause disruptions...JAG is what unlocked that special part of my brain and made me realize that good things aren't going to just come to me. If I want to pursue a successful future, the beginning of that road starts now."

JAG CT is a program of the Hartford Consortium for Higher Education, and is funded with a contract with the state of Connecticut Department of Labor with support from the Court Support Services Division and Departments of Education, Social Services, Children and Families, Correction and Economic Development.

JAG is a state-based national program which for more than 35 years has helped young people graduate from high school and continue to postsecondary success and quality jobs and careers. RECOGNITIONS AND AWARDS

Resolution Honoring John Choquette

***Whereas**, John Choquette was born and raised in the town of East Hartford and has always exhibited a deep caring for his hometown and every person who resides here; and*

***Whereas**, John Choquette worked for the city of Hartford as the Director of Social Services for many years, and*

***Whereas**, upon retiring from the city of Hartford, John returned home to East Hartford for his second career; and*

***Whereas**, John Choquette has calmly and effectively served the community of East Hartford for twenty one years as Social Services Director, Development Director and Assistant to the Mayor; and*

***Whereas**, throughout his tenure serving East Hartford, John has had the respect and support of the East Hartford Town Council, always providing answers – in not just a few words – to any Council inquiry; and*

***Whereas**, the East Hartford Chamber of Commerce recently recognized John as “Public Servant of the Year”; and*

OPPORTUNITY FOR RESIDENTS TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL ON AGENDA ITEMS

Susan Kniep, 44-46 and 50 Olde Roberts Street, (1) congratulated John Choquette on his retirement; (2) would like to receive a copy of the proposed contract with TaxServ – the debt collection agency which may be hired by the town to collect overdue automobile and personal property taxes; and (3) believes that a presentation on the OPEB contribution is necessary to fully inform the citizens of East Hartford.

Mayor Leclerc (1) wished all a Happy New Years; (2) asked Police Chief Sansom to address the Council on a recent police response to criminal activity which involved injuries to three East Hartford Police officers; (3) the EHPD reported 752 calls for the holiday season – December 24th through January 3rd; (4) the Brian Aselton snow dash will be January 10th; (5) the Mayor has submitted the town of East Hartford Legislative proposals for 2016 to the town's legislative delegation; (6) tax bills are due February 1st; (7) the town will pick up Christmas trees through January 8th; (8) Dorian Lockett was introduced to the Council as John Choquette's replacement; (9) shared a documentary video with the Council from Pratt & Whitney on the newly renovated Raymond Library; and (10) supports the OPEB contribution as presented.

COMMUNICATIONS AND PETITIONS

CT Veterans' Day Parade: Certificate of Appreciation

Chair Kehoe announced that, due to East Hartford's participation in the CT Veterans' Day parade held in Hartford on November 8, 2015, the Planning and Executive Committees for the Connecticut Veterans Fund awarded the East Hartford Town Council a certificate of appreciation.

OPEB Contribution: Section 10-52 (b) of the East Hartford Code of Ordinances

Pursuant to Section 10-52 (b) of the town's code of ordinances, a transfer of \$1,596,840 – which represents the surplus over 8% from the undesignated reserve fund –will be processed in January and deposited into the Retiree Benefit Trust Fund. This money will help fund the town's retirees' pension and health insurance costs. A more detailed presentation will take place at the February 16th Town Council meeting.

Collector of Revenue: TaxServ Announcement

Michael Walsh, Finance Director, updated the Council on the possibility of contracting a debt collection agency, specifically TaxServ, to assist in collecting overdue taxes on (1) motor vehicle delinquencies over one year old; (2) personal property taxes from businesses; and (3) orphan properties – defined as those parcels where a tax lien sale has not produced a bidder.

Resignation of Kirk Allison from the Veterans' Affairs Commission

Chair Kehoe announced the resignation of Kirk Allison from the Veterans' Affairs Commission. He thanked Mr. Allison for his dedication to the community through his service on this commission.

NEW BUSINESS

Banc of America Public Capital Corporation: \$4.625 Million Lease for Capital Equipment and Building Improvements

 to **adopt** the following resolution:

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF EAST HARTFORD, CONNECTICUT AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A MASTER EQUIPMENT LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH BANC OF AMERICA PUBLIC CAPITAL CORP, AS LESSOR, AND SEPARATE SCHEDULES THERETO FOR THE ACQUISITION, PURCHASE, FINANCING AND LEASING OF CERTAIN EQUIPMENT WITHIN THE TERMS HEREIN PROVIDED; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF OTHER DOCUMENTS REQUIRED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND AUTHORIZING ALL OTHER ACTIONS NECESSARY TO THE CONSUMMATION OF THE TRANSACTIONS CONTEMPLATED BY THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Town of East Hartford, Connecticut (the "*Town*"), a political subdivision of the State of Connecticut (the "*State*"), is authorized by the laws of the State to purchase, acquire and lease the personal property (tangible and intangible) for the benefit of the Town and its inhabitants and to enter into contracts with respect thereto; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Town (the "*Board*") has determined that a need exists for the acquisition, purchase and financing of the property set forth on Schedule A (collectively, the "*Equipment*") on the terms herein provided; and

WHEREAS, in order to acquire such Equipment, the Town proposes to enter into that certain Master Equipment Lease/Purchase Agreement (the "*Agreement*") with Banc of America Public Capital Corp (or one

of its affiliates), as lessor (the "Lessor"), substantially in the proposed form presented to the Board at this meeting, and separate Schedules thereto substantially in the form attached to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it for the benefit of the Town and for the efficient and effective administration thereof to enter into the Agreement and separate Schedules relating thereto from time to time as provided in the Agreement for the purchase, acquisition, financing and leasing of the Equipment to be therein described on the terms and conditions therein and herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the governing body of the Town as follows:

Section 1. Findings and Determinations. It is hereby found and determined that the terms of the Agreement (including the form of Schedule of Property and the form of Rental Payment Schedule, both attached thereto), in the form presented to the Town Council at this meeting, are in the best interests of the Town for the acquisition, purchase, financing and leasing of the Equipment.

Section 2. Approval of Documents. The form, terms and provisions of the Agreement (including the form of Schedule of Property and the form of Rental Payment Schedule, both attached thereto) are hereby approved in substantially the forms presented at this meeting, with such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the Mayor and the Director of Finance of the Town (the "Authorized Officials") executing the same, the execution of such documents being conclusive evidence of such approval. The Authorized Officials are each hereby authorized and directed to sign and deliver on behalf of the Town the Agreement, each Schedule thereto under which a separate Lease (as defined in the Agreement) is created, each Rental Payment Schedule attached thereto and any related exhibits attached thereto if and when required; provided, however, that, without further authorization from the Town Council, (a) the aggregate principal component of Rental Payments under all Leases entered into pursuant to the Agreement shall not exceed \$4,625,000; (b) the maximum term under any Lease entered into pursuant to the Agreement shall not exceed eleven (11) years; and (c) the maximum interest rate used to determine the interest component of Rental Payments under each Lease shall not exceed the lesser of the maximum rate permitted by law or three (3%) per annum. The Authorized Officials may sign and deliver Leases to the Lessor on behalf of the Town pursuant to the Agreement on such terms and conditions as they shall determine are in the best interests of the Town up to the maximum aggregate principal component, maximum term and maximum interest rate provided above. The foregoing authorization shall remain in effect for a period of two years from the date hereof during which the Authorized Officials are authorized to sign and deliver Leases pursuant to the Agreement on the terms and conditions herein provided and to be provided in each such Lease.

Section 3. Other Actions Authorized. The officers and employees of the Town shall take all action necessary or reasonably required by the parties to the Agreement to carry out, give effect to and consummate the transactions, contemplated thereby (including the execution and delivery of Final Acceptance Certificates, Escrow Agreements and any tax certificate and agreement, as contemplated in the Agreement) and to take all action necessary in conformity therewith, including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of any closing and other documents required to be delivered in connection with the Agreement and each Lease.

Section 4. No General Liability. Nothing contained in this Resolution, the Agreement, any Lease, any Escrow Agreement nor any other instrument shall be construed with respect to the Town as incurring a pecuniary liability or charge upon the general credit of the Town or against its taxing power, nor shall the breach of any agreement contained in this Resolution, the Agreement, any Lease, any Escrow Agreement or any other instrument or document executed in connection therewith impose any pecuniary liability upon the Town or any charge upon its general credit or against its taxing power, except to the extent that the Rental Payments payable under each Lease entered into pursuant to the Agreement are limited obligations of the Town, subject to annual appropriation, as provided in the Agreement.

Section 5. Appointment of Authorized Town Representatives. The Mayor and the Director of Finance of the Town are each hereby designated to act as authorized representatives of the Town for purposes of each Lease and the related Escrow Agreement until such time as the governing body of the Town shall designate any other or different authorized representative for purposes of the Agreement and any Lease or Escrow Agreement.

Section 6. Declaration of Official Intent. The Town hereby expresses its official intent pursuant to Section 1.150-2 of the Federal Income Tax Regulations, Title 26 (the "Regulations"), to reimburse expenditures paid sixty days prior to and anytime after the date of passage of this Resolution in the maximum amount of the Equipment with the proceeds of bonds, notes, tax-exempt leases, or other obligations ("Tax Exempt Obligations") authorized to be issued by the Town. The Tax Exempt Obligations shall be issued to reimburse such expenditures not later than 18 months after the later of the date of the expenditure or the substantial completion of the Equipment, or such later date

the Regulations may authorize. The Town hereby certifies that the intention to reimburse as expressed herein is based upon its reasonable expectations as of this date. The Director of Finance or his designee is authorized to pay Equipment expenses in accordance herewith pending the issuance of the Tax Exempt Obligations.

Section 7. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval and adoption.

Note: The Town Council noted that its longstanding lease purchase policy is to limit the lease period to no more than 4 years. However, in light of: (1) the overwhelming and uniform support for the bond referendum questions; (2) the voter turnout exceeded 20% but very slightly less than 20% of the voters cast ballots on the referendum questions; (3) there was consensus in the community and in the Town Council that these projects need to move forward to address potential health and safety issues; (4) the life expectancy of the capital improvements exceed the lease period; and (5) leasing is less expensive than bonding, the Town Council agreed to a lease period of 11 years.

RE: **Properties Recommended for Tax Lien Sale – Referral to Tax Policy Subcommittee**

Attached please find the list of properties being recommended for the town's annual tax lien sale totaling \$902,463.

Please note that all amounts are compiled through December 31, 2015 and will increase based on the application of interest and lien fees through the date of sale. Based on prior lien sales, the policy criteria applied by the Tax Office that results in a property being selected for lien sale dictates that any real estate delinquency in excess of \$10,000 or any amount when the delinquency spans any portion of three grand list years will be sent for sale.

As background information related to the process followed by the Tax Office, the collection process completed for each grand list year is summarized below.

- The tax bill first installment legal notice is published (the middle of June).
- An individual tax bill is printed and mailed to the property address (late June).
- If full payment is not received, an individual delinquent letter is mailed (August).
- The tax bill second installment legal notice is published (late December).
- If full payment is not received, an individual demand letter is mailed (February).
- If amounts remain unpaid, an individual notice of intention to file lien letter is mailed (May).
- If amounts remain unpaid, a lien is filed by the Tax Collector (by June 30th).

As was done the past few years, the town will issue a tax lien sale request for proposal (RFP). When the town has accepted bids in the past, the town was able to collect 100% of the tax due on the parcels when it sold its lien. On some properties, the owner came forward and entered into an agreement with the town to deposit an initial payment approximating 25% of the taxes due while agreeing to retire the remaining balance over 36 months while keeping new taxes current.

Like past lien sales, the town will advertise these properties and request sealed bids . The bids received by the town will be opened and analyzed by the Administration who then will return to the Town Council with appropriate recommendations for sale. The Finance Department, including the Tax Office, will work closely with Corporation Counsel to facilitate this sale.

In closing, while it is regrettable that the town has to initiate this action, despite our best efforts, we have been unable to secure collection with these particular properties. Accordingly, to maintain a fair and equitable tax collection system for the town, we must initiate this action.
