146 Prospect Street

Rich Gentile, Assistant Corporation Counsel, initiated a discussion regarding this 7.14 acre parcel. The property abuts land that the Town owns. The parcel is mostly wetlands which makes it non-developable. There is not a lot of maintenance to this parcel — possibly some trimming by the street line. The taxes on the parcel are current. The assessment has been reduced to approximately 13,400 which equates to about \$600 in taxes. Attorney Gentile said the appraisal can be waived since the land is being donated to the Town and thinks that we do not need a survey of this property. A phase I environmental study, which takes 4-6 weeks to process, would cost about \$3,000 which may be in the Town Council's budget. Tim Bockus, the Public Works Director, reported that it made sense for the Town to take the land.
