Public notice is hereby given that the Town Council of the Town of East Hartford, Connecticut, will hold a  
public hearing on **Monday, September 17, 2018 at 7:15p.m.** in the Town Council Chambers, 740 Main Street,  
East Hartford, Connecticut, to hear public comment on revisions to Chapter 10 of the Town of East Hartford  
Code of Ordinances, Sections 10-41, 10-42, 10-43 and 10-52, which revisions result in the proposed "Fiscally  
Responsible Funding of Long-term Liabilities" Ordinance.

Any person(s) wishing to express an opinion on this matter may do so at this meeting. Copies of the proposed  
ordinance are on file in the Town Clerk's Office and the Town Council's Office.

Chair Kehoe summarized the reason for this proposed ordinance. There are a number of long-  
term obligations that the town needs to meet; the one most people are familiar with is the pension  
for town employees. However, there are other liabilities that the town is responsible for – (1) heart  
& hypertension claims; (2) employee health benefits; and (3) general and automobile liability. This  
ordinance will respond to these other long-term liabilities.

The following citizens came forward:

Susan Kniep, 50 Olde Roberts Street, requested a complete report of any and all benefits that the  
East Hartford taxpayers today are facing for the future.

Don Currey, 14 Martin Circle, Town Treasurer, commended the Council on its ability to work with  
the various sectors of government for the good of the town's future. Mr. Currey also thanked them  
for taking the initiative to write an ordinance which will be a standard for future Councils to follow.
